## HURRICANE KIT CHECK-LIST

## COVERING POSSIBILITIES

- Water (7 gallons/person); bottled or disinfected for drinking and cooking, brushing teeth and for pets, washing hands etc.
- Baby food, diapers and formula
- Battery operated radio
- Bleach liquid chlorine or tablets to purify water
- Bucket to dip water
- Butane lighters
- Camera and spare memory card(s)
- Candles
- Cards, games, books
- Charcoal
- Cleaning and sanitizing supplies
- Cooler
- Duct tape
- Eating utensils (disposable)
- Emergency cooking utensils (grill or camping stove)
- Emergency phone numbers
- Extension cords (heavy duty, three pronged with surge protector)
- Extra batteries
- Extra newspaper
- Extra prescription medicine
- Fire extinguisher (if possible)
- First -Aid kit
- Flashlights
- Fuel for car (DO NOT STORE INSIDE)
- Gas for grill (fill tank, but do not store inside)
- Heavy plastic (to cover roof if damaged)
- Ice jug and ice
- Lantern with extra fuel
- Manual can openers
- Matches
- Mosquito netting
- Mosquito repellent
- Non-perishable canned or packaged foods and beverages
- Non-electric clock
- Pet food
- Lots of trash bags
- Rat traps
- Rope
- Sleeping bags
- Small BBQ for cooking
- Tarpaulins
- Toiletries
- Tools (hammers, gloves, nails, saw)
